#### **Charger Operation**

- 1. Charge indoors.
- 2. For use with VALUE VB518, VB918 battery pack only.
- 3. When not charging, please remove the power cord of the charger from the power plug in time.
- 4. Push battery into port until it engages with lock.
- 5. A tone is played when charge starts or completes
- 6. When charge is complete, press the lock and pull out the battery.
- 7. Indicate light is on during charging.



### Warning

- 1. Don't expose charger to rain or water.
- This charger is only for VB518,VB918 battery. Don't charge any other type of battery.
- 3. Keep the charger clean.
- 4. Check the charger before using.
- 5. Do not use in a flammable environment.
- 6. Disconnect the power cord when not in use.
- 7. This charger is only for professionals to operate.
- 8. This charger should only be repaired by qualified individuals. Please contact VALUE for charger service.
- The charger is not to be used by persons (including children) who are required assistance, unless they have been given supervision or instruction.
- 10. Children being supervised not to play with the appliance.
- 11. Do not attempt to recharge any non-rechargeable batteries.

## III. Preparation

- 1. Before initial use, please charge battery to full capacity.
- Unscrew the oil fill cap. Fill oil to the middle level of lens. Start the pump to run for 1 minute. Add oil if its level is low.

#### Note:

1. Fill oil slowly to prevent oil spill.

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2. Low oil will affect performance. Too much oil will cause mist spray.



#### IV. Operation, Maintenance

#### **Pump Operation**

- Connect the vacuum pump to the system to be evacuated.
  Open the check valve.
- 2. Check the seal to assure there is no leak.
- 3. After the evacuation work, stop pump and close the system valve.
- 4. Disconnect the hoses.
- 5. Cap the inlet ports to prevent particle falling into pump.



#### Note:

- 1. Check oil during operation, if oil is low add it immediately.
- 2. When the battery is full, it's 21V. When it lowers down to around 16V, it starts beep. It is suggested to close the valve on the vacuum or system to hold the vacuum once the alert begins. You will have 3 minutes to close the valves once the alert begins to beep before the battery runs out.

#### Warning

- 1. Don't run pump over 3 minutes when it's open to atmosphere.
- 2. Recover the refrigerant before evacuation.

#### Maintenance


1. Pump Oil

Oil type and condition is an important factor for the vacuum level. To get the best performance, it is recommented to use VALUE pump oil.

- Ti: Change oil immediately when it becomes cloudy or dirty.
- 2. Oil Change
- 2.1 If pump is cold, run pump for 1 minute.
- 2.2 Open the inlet when running pump, to get the oil out of the pump cylinder. Stop the pump and then open the oil drain valve. Dispose the oil according to local regulation. Tilt the pump to drain the residual oil.
- 2.3 Screw back the oil drain valve.
- 2.4 Open the oil fill cap to fill oil.

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## VRP-2SLi/VRP-2DLi/VRP-4DLi EXPLODED VIEW







	Secondary air inlet connection cap loose on the air inlet port.	Tighten the cap.			
	Damaged rubber ring inside the secondary air inlet connection cap.	Replace the rubber ring.			
	3. The volume of oil is insufficient.	Add oil to the center line of the oil display.			
	Pump oil becomes opaque or absorbed too many impurities.	Replace with new oil.			
Low Vacuum	<ol><li>The pump's oil entry hole is clogged or the oil supply is insufficient.</li></ol>	Clean the oil entry hole, clean the oil filter.			
vacuum	<ol><li>6.The pump connecting hoses, manifold or system has a leak.</li></ol>	Inspect the connecting hose gaskets and system, repair leaks.			
	7. The pump selection is wrong.	Check the size of the container to be evacuated, recalculate and select an appropriate pump model.			
	The pump has been used for too long, damage and wear to components caused increased gaps between parts.	Inspect and repair, or replace the pump.			
Oil leak	1. Damaged oil seal.	Replace the oil seal.

	1. Oil temperature is too low.	Exposed the air entry hole to the external atmosphere, and remove the oil fume filtration device. Use a screwdriver to turn the engine axle in an anti-clockwise direction.			
Start-up	Motor, power source or circuit board malfunction	Inspect and repair.			
problems	3. Foreign objects entered the pump.	Inspect and remove.			
	4. Voltage supply is excessively low or high.	Inspect the power source voltage.			
	5. Overload trips.	After overload trip occurs, switch kept On. Remove the power plug, wait for approximately 30 seconds before inspecting and repairing.			

#### Notes:

- 1. The pump is inverter driven and the motor has over-current /overload protection, please troubleshoot after overload resets.
- 2. If the above methods cannot resolve your problems, please contact your nearest distributor or take the pump to a repair center. We will do our best o provide you with a quick turnaround to keep you working.
